

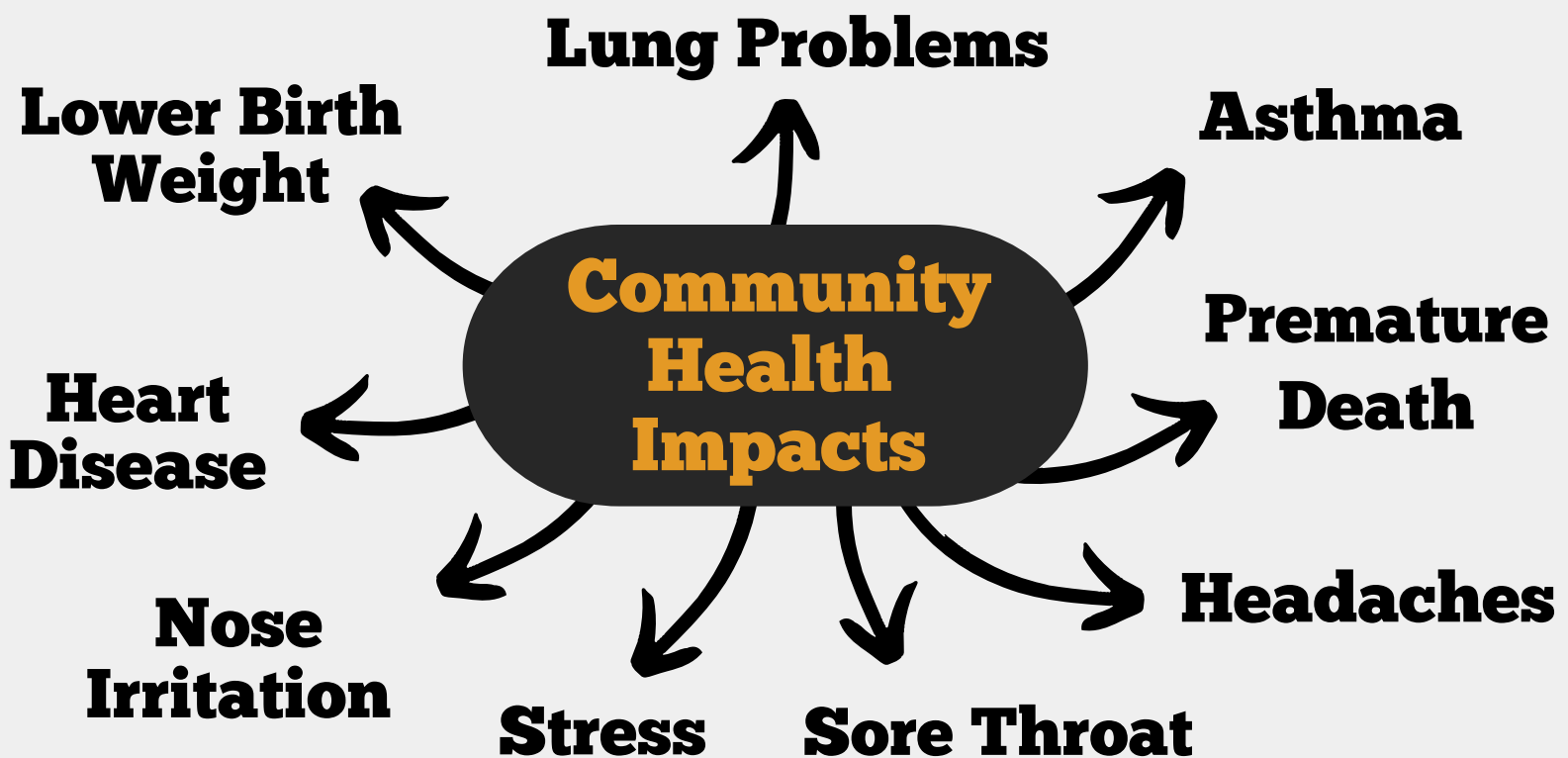

What is a railyard?

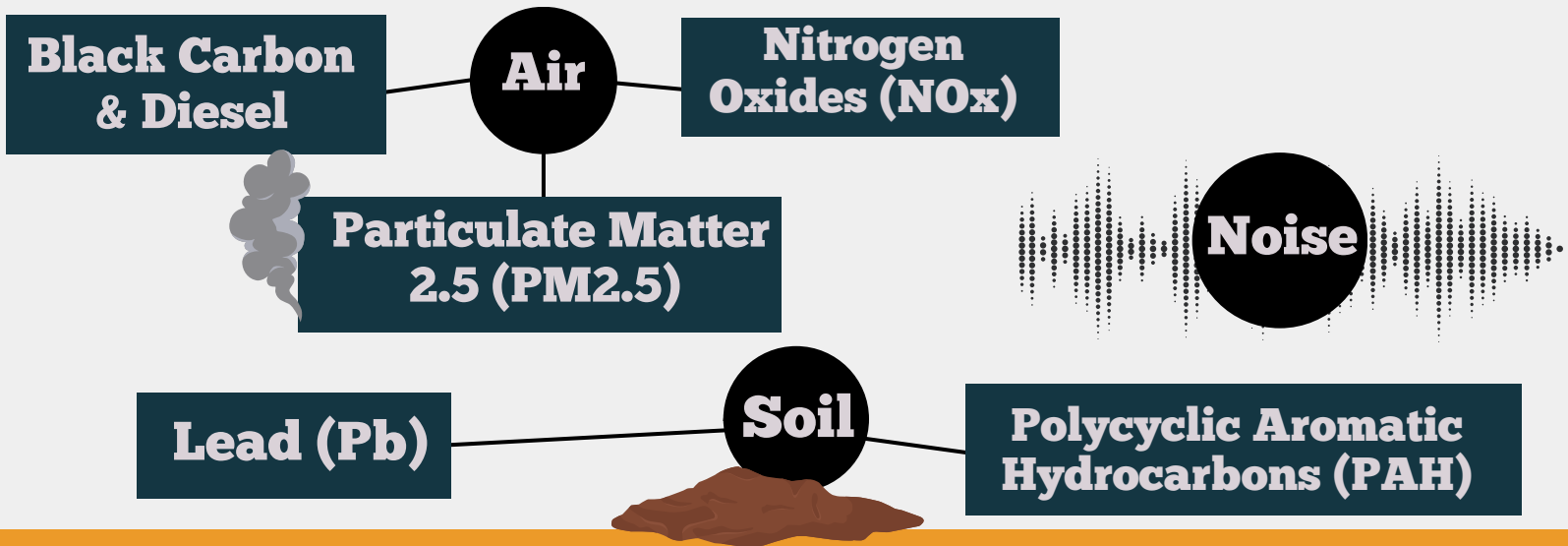
Railyards are hubs for trains, trucks, and other diesel equipment to distribute and move cargo



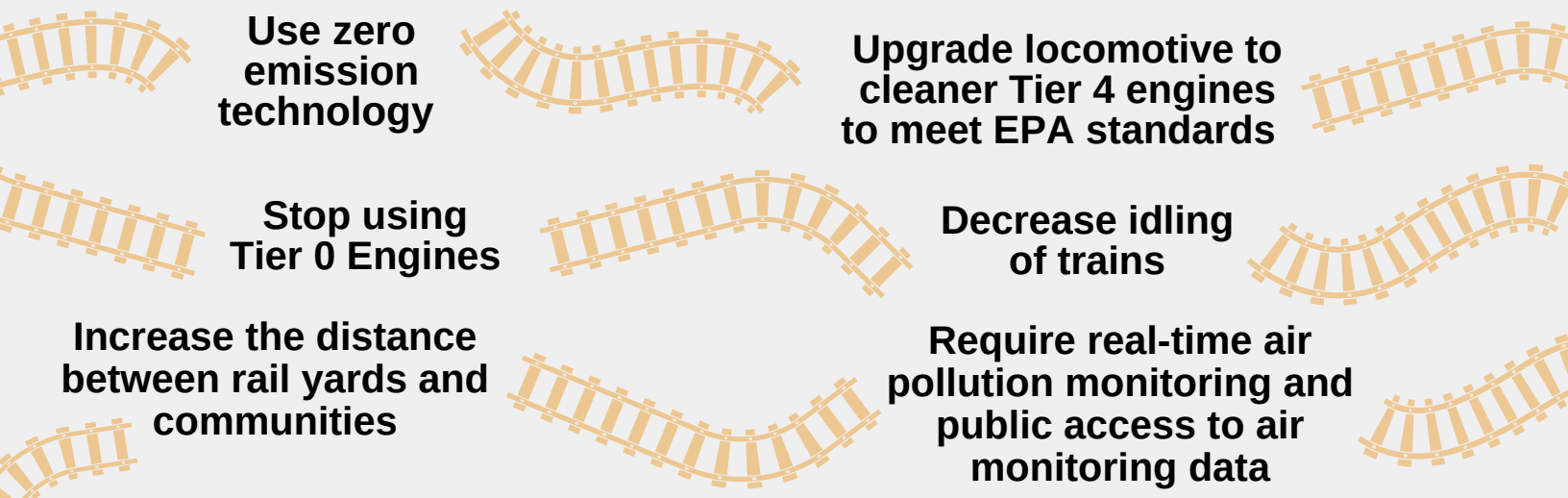
Vulnerable populations include children, seniors, railyard workers, and residents in historically marginalized communities

Railyards Indirect Source Rule (ISR)

What is it?

New rule to reduce NO_x emissions from mobile sources at railyards

Includes train cars, drayage trucks, and other cargo handling equipment

Applies to all current and future railyards in region

What does it do?

Requires railyards to use cleaner technology and zero-emissions equipment

Requires reporting of air emission reductions

Holds the railroads accountable to SCAQMD and communities
